

## Environmental Policy Statement

Any Company employee who supervises or manages the use of work equipment shall have received adequate training for the purposes of the Environment, including training in the methods that may be adopted when using the work equipment, any risks that such use may entail and precautions to be taken. Employees will be consulted on all matters relating to the Environment at work.

All necessary resources, people, time, funding, information, instruction, training and supervision will be provided to ensure this Policy is implemented.

The Company is committed to continuous improvement to its Environmental performance.

Mr G. Little and the Internal Auditor will monitor the operation of this Policy.

The Company Board will periodically review this policy and set objectives and targets for ongoing continual improvement and prevention of pollution

This Policy will be reviewed on an annual basis to reflect any changes in legislation.
